## Installment Payments

\$25.00 fee in addition to 1<sup>st</sup> half of registration fee is due upon registration.

First Installment (50%) plus fee is due **day of registration**.

Second installment (50%) is due **October 15, 2011**.

## Studio Policy

- **TUITION IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- No admittance to class 10 minutes after class has begun.
- Class schedule may change due to enrollment.
- Absences must be made up within current semester of missed sessions.
- Teachers have the authority to keep a student from participation if incorrect attire is worn, or if hair does not meet the dress requirement.

## Dress Code

No baggy sweats, T-shirts, boxers or other loose clothing for children's classes.

No jewelry.

Hair must be pulled back and secure.

For children's ballet/tap combination classes, students must wear black leotard with pink, **footed** tight

All students must wear appropriate shoes for ballet, tap, jazz, and hip-hop classes.

**Classes require six (6) students to make and are subject to change or cancellation.**
